1. Beth Meyer provided a thorough review of data from DIBELS, MAP, and NC-ENSI, as well as standards-based assessments for the first trimester. A cross-comparison of grades levels for reading and math scores was provided, identifying strengths and areas of growth. The administrative team has been discussing having family nights dedicated to content so that families can partner in their child's success. Jessica Glenn raised concern with absences and tardies and David Jarmon explained current policy and truancy process. Possible revisions are forthcoming to help support families in adhering to the expectations. Jessica Glenn also noted the need to improve handwriting and letter formation. Ideas were shared for professional development and all teachers should collaborate on a whole-school goal to address these needs.
